Reflections:

I made a mistake. I know it wasn't the first and I am also sure it won't be the last. In my sermon on Sunday, I made a mistake. I referred to Jesus telling Peter that he was the rock on which he would build his church. So far, so good. But during my message I stated that this happened in the Upper Room during Christ's last meeting with the disciples. Here is where I went astray. This, in fact, was not when and where this encounter took place. It actually took place in Caesarea Philippi when Jesus asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" and then followed up that question with, "But what about you? Who do you say I am?"

Peter, who often opens his mouth and makes you doubt whether he put any good thought into it, replies "You are the Christ, the son of the living God." That is when Jesus tells him that he is a rock. That is when Jesus tells him that he will build his church on that rock and that the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

I appreciate that someone in the congregation, in humility, shared with me my error. He wasn't condemning or criticizing, simply trying to help me avoid confusion. Not a big deal, just a little guidance. That is the role that we should have in one another's lives as brothers and sisters in Christ. We should be able to humbly let one another know when we have strayed – not to gain an upper hand or to feel superior, but to help one another be the best followers of Christ that we can. God created us as a family and scriptures often use family relationships as an analogy for the church. May we live out our lives together as the family that God intends for us to be!

My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back, let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins.

And that's ok; because God offers us forgiveness through Jesus' death on the cross. The problem, however, is that too many people are still trying to earn their way to God. They are stuck with a head-knowledge of God, rather than a personal, life-changing experience of the heart.

You see, when we finally experience the truth of the good news of Christ on a personal level – lives begin to change. The undeserved grace and forgiveness that comes from faith in Jesus begins to transform our hearts. And as hearts change, lives change.

Suddenly, our desires begin to line up with God's desires. We have an inner *want to* and an empowerment to *do so* because of the grace that we've received. Life change begins in the heart.

Are you struggling with restlessness in your life? An uneasiness in your spirit? Maybe you've never *really* encountered God on a 'heart' level. Maybe you're like too many people calling themselves Christians, but who have a head-based faith. You believe the Bible but have never really understood it on a personal level. Or, maybe you've rejected God because of the actions of flawed people in the name of religion. The truth is simple: no matter your past, your pain or your doubts, God's love offers us peace. God's grace offers us a fresh start. God's forgiveness frees us from our past sins and shame. Knowing God's heart begins to transform our own hearts – and that is life-changing. The greatest miracle in life is a transformed heart.
