I have heard some pastors and church people say that there are churches where they don't want to hear about the blood of Christ. That they want to hear about love and social justice and living together in peace and all kinds of warm and fuzzy stuff. They say that they don't want to hear about sin and hell and the need for Jesus' blood. I have to say that I have never been in such a situation. Churches that I have served have always desired for me to preach the truth of the gospel. They have had not had a problem with singing "Are you washed in the Blood?" or "Nothing but the Blood" or other hymns that refer to the fact that we are sinners and that the only solution to that problem is the blood of Christ. So, I will continue to preach Jesus Christ and him crucified.

I know this may have been sort of a roundabout way to get here, but I want to talk a little more about blood. Blood is key. In addition to the fact that we need, for eternity's sake depend on the blood of Christ for our salvation, we also depend on our own blood running through our veins to keep us alive.
